All Saints' College is a pioneering academic institution with multifaceted activities in various academic and research aspects. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College will serve as the liaising body for facilitating the activities under the MoU.

CLOUD INFOTECH is an existing company having its office at Trivandrum is currently one of the vendors identified by The College for the supply of electronic requirements including computers and peripherals to The College.

Article I PURPOSE

This MoU is envisaged as a means of a regulated e-waste management system that will ensure the proper collection and handling of e-waste and the extraction of valuable resources from e-waste. The regulated e-waste management system will also safeguard the environment and our health.



Article II SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding sets for the terms and understanding between All Saints' College, Thiruvananthapuram and CLOUD INFOTECH , Trivandrum for the purpose of disposal of E waste including damaged and outdated computers, monitors, servers, projectors, printers and printing accessories, network system accessories

The regulated e-waste management system is based on the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) approach, where producers bear the responsibility for the collection and treatment of their products when they reach end-of-life.

Article III FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

This MoU does not bind both the parties with financial commitments of any kind for the purpose of execution of its objectives.

Article IV SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

Any differing viewpoint or interpretation of this MoU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation. No part in this agreement shall be construed as creating a legal relationship between parties, except as specifically provided in this MoU.

Article V DURATION OF AGREEMENT

This MoU is at will and may be modified by the mutual consent of authorised officials from the College and the Company. It shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from The College and The Company and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the parties by mutual consent.
